

Pistol Brace Sale!

All Stabilizing Braces & Firearms w/ Stabilizing Braces Are On Sale

By now, most have heard the ATF has reclassified pistols with stabilizing braces on them as “short barreled rifles” that require an NFA tax stamp. Although the ruling has not been published in the Federal Register, once it is, people with these guns will be required to either remove the brace or apply for an NFA tax stamp within 120 days. Our understanding of the new regulation is that stabilizing braces by themselves not attached to a gun are not illegal and can be bought and sold without any special action. The good news, if you can call it that, is the tax stamp which normally costs \$200 is free within this 120 day period. It is possible that once the pistol is registered as a short barreled rifle and has a tax stamp, an individual may not have to keep the pistol brace on it and can swap it out with a real shoulder stock. This essentially lets you convert any pistol with an existing stabilizing brace on it into a short barreled rifle for free!*
