Ohio Concealed Carry Training

Our *Ohio Concealed Carry* classes exceed the requirements set forth in Ohio law to be able to carry a concealed handgun. Before taking this class, you should have some familiarity with and be comfortable with safely handling and firing a handgun. This is *NOT* a class for someone who is new to shooting. If you are new to handguns, we recommend that you take the Basic Handgun class or get a private lesson from one of our instructors before taking the concealed carry training.

Cost: \$99.99 Payment is required in advance to reserve your place in the class.

Class Days/Time: Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday & Sunday from 10:00 a.m. to 6:30 p.m.

Topics Covered

Ohio law requires eight (8) hours of training that covers the following areas:

- Ability to name, explain, and demonstrate the rules for safe handling or a handgun and proper storage practices for handguns and ammunition
- Ability to demonstrate and explain how to handle ammunition in a safe manner
- Ability to demonstrate the knowledge, skills, and attitude necessary to shoot a handgun in safe manner
- Complete an examination that tests competency
- Physical demonstration of the attitude necessary to shoot a handgun in a safe manner

Equipment Requirements (What to Bring)

You can bring your own handgun (unloaded and in a case) or, if you do not have a handgun, you can use a rental gun and purchase ammo for it. Handguns and ammo are **NOT PERMITTED** in the classroom. Keep them in your vehicle under the class goes to the range.

- 50 rounds of target/range ammo
- Pen and paper to take notes
- Drinks, snacks. You'll get a 30-minute break for lunch during the class
- Appropriate clothing (no sandals or low-cut tops)
- Ear/eye protection, or you can borrow ours

Instructors
